

# Scholarship Guidelines

**Principal's Scholarship of Distinction - \$2,000 Scholarship of Distinction - \$1,000 Scholarship of Excellence - \$500**  
Scholarships range from \$500 to \$2,000 and will be awarded to eligible Hanson students

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE

HANSON students must complete the form and submit it to the Academic Department at your respective campus. Scholarship application forms can be submitted started on **March 18, 2019** and the deadline for submission is **Grade Review Day, April 18, 2019**

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will be awarded to the selected Hanson international students who are currently registered. Please note that first semester, Scheduled Break, and graduating students (on their first or last semester for their program of study) are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to participate.

### Scholarship of Excellence

This scholarship is awarded to students who have shown a GPA of 3.5 or higher for the current semester; who are active in school events; and who have good conduct (no incident reports). Selection will be based on students who meet the criteria and will be selected by the Scholarship Committee.

- Scholarship of Excellence for Self-Discipline - \$500
- Scholarship of Excellence for Improvement - \$500
- Scholarship of Excellence for Participation - \$500
- Scholarship of Excellence for Academics - \$500

### Scholarship of Distinction

This scholarship is awarded to students who have shown a GPA of 3.7 or higher for the current semester; who are active in school events; and who have good conduct (no incident reports). Selection will be based on reference from your current instructors and the Scholarship Committee.

- Scholarship of Distinction - \$1000
- Principal's Scholarship of Distinction - \$2000

## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Read the Selection Criteria and Eligibility Requirements to determine your eligibility.
- Complete the Hanson Scholarship Application Form ([www.canadahanson.com](http://www.canadahanson.com)). Incomplete forms will not be considered.
- Complete and attach to your application your **500-750 word** response.
- Ask ONE (1) of your instructors to complete and submit a Faculty Reference for you and email it directly to the appropriate Department by the deadline. You will not see the completed form.
- Submit your completed Hanson Scholarship Application Form to the appropriate Department. The deadline for submission is **Grade Review Day, April 18, 2019**.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

### 1) Student Characteristics

Applicants who have demonstrated the following characteristics are eligible for a scholarship:

<b>A. Self Discipline</b>	Refers to students who demonstrate consistent and proper conduct and good behaviour, in accordance to Hanson’s class behavior expectations, policies, and procedures. Examples: NO incident reports in their student file (i.e. no cheating incident reports).
<b>A. Participation</b>	Refers to students who actively participate in college school activities and events, and who participate in – and contribute to – their classes in a positive manner.
<b>B. Academic Standing</b>	Refers to a student who has a GPA of 3.5 and above (Scholarship of Excellence or a GPA of 3.7 and above (Scholarship of Distinction)

### 2) Good Standing in Tuition Payments

Applicants must not have any history of late or incomplete tuition payments, as according to the college’s tuition fee policies.

### 3) Attendance

Applicants must have a history of good attendance

### 4) References

ALL applicants must obtain **one (1) reference letter** from one (1) of their current semester instructors

## STUDENT AGREEMENT AND COMPLIANCE

Students acknowledge and agree to comply with the following when they submit a scholarship application:

1. Note that a student cannot be granted with the same scholarship twice.
2. Scholarships are not guaranteed to every applicant. Only successful applicants will be contacted about their award.
3. All applicants applying for scholarships agree to accept the conditions and rules of the application and selection process and understands that the applicant is subject to applicable laws.
4. Each winner authorizes Hanson or Cambrian College to use his/her name and photograph for publicity purposes without remuneration.
5. Cambrian at Hanson reserves the right to end the scholarship, adjust the amounts, and/or modify its conditions from time to time.
6. Scholarship recipients will each be given a T4A form in February of the following year for income tax purposes.
7. Your ability to follow the application instructions independently will be considered.
